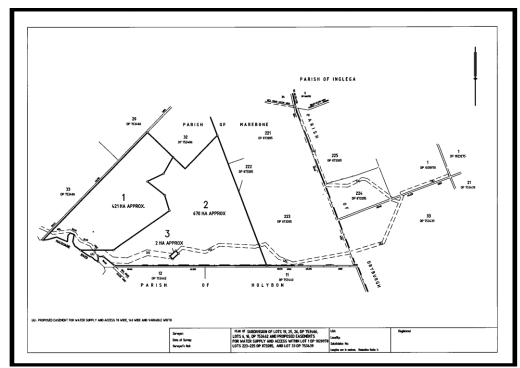

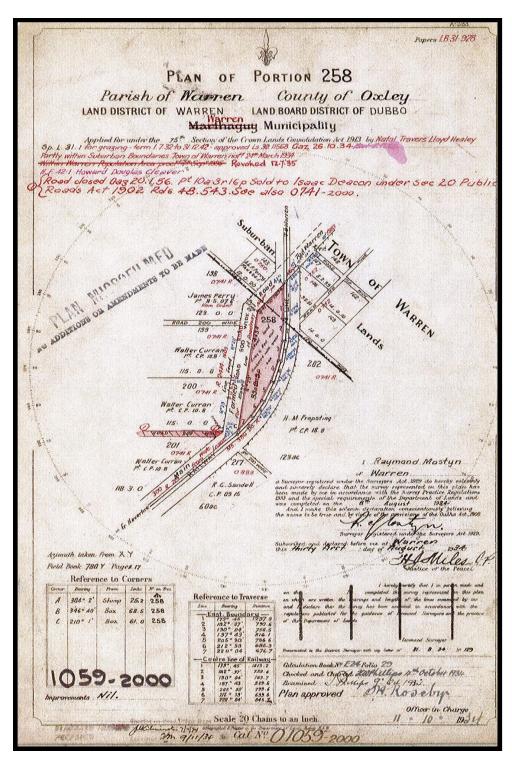

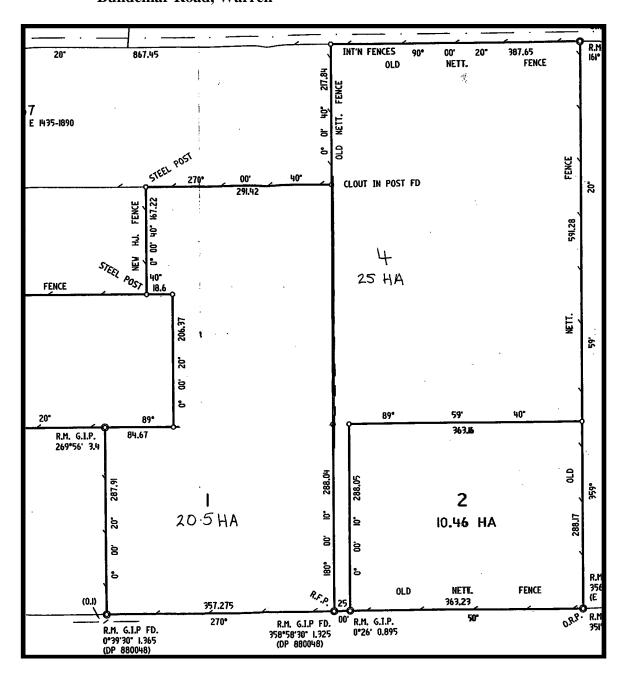


**EXISTING LOTS**

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### MAYORAL MINUTES

The Mayor advised that the following items of general interest and Council business transacted through the period since the last Council Meeting.

- \* The Mayor acknowledged Warren's Australia Day activities and thanked organisers Councillor Taylor and Darren Arthur for their input into making this a successful event. He also expressed his appreciation to the volunteers who had helped.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2016, himself and the General Manager had undertaken a tour of the northern end of the Shire. It was most certainly sobering to see the contrast from one end of the Shire to the other.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2016 he had attended the Auscott Scholarship Presentation Ceremony. The two (2) worthy winners were Annabelle Taylor who was awarded the Auscott Undergraduate Education Scholarship and Prue Murray who was awarded the Bruce & Robyn Loder Education Scholarship. This is the 54th year of Scholarships in the Macquarie Valley and the program has now expanded to the three (3) other valleys in which Auscott operates.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 8<sup>th</sup> February 2016 that himself and the General Manager had attended a meeting in Gilgandra of the four (4) OROC Rural Councils being; Bogan, Coonamble, Gilgandra and Warren. This meeting was held to have a look at each Councils IPART proposal and to examine the Stage 1 amendments to the Local Government Act.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 11<sup>th</sup> February 2016 he had attended a Regional Weeds Action Plan Meeting in Dubbo.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 18<sup>th</sup> February 2016 he had been invited and had attended a reception in Dubbo held by the NSW Governor.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 20<sup>th</sup> February 2016 he was invited by Dubbo City Council to attend the 7 Sopranos held at Dubbo Regional Theatre and Convention Centre.

- \* The Mayor advised that on the 2nd March 2016, an IPWEA Regional Forum will be held in Warren and he had been invited to perform the official opening.
- \* The Mayor advised that on the 4<sup>th</sup> March 2016, himself and the General Manager would be attending an OROC Board Meeting to be held in Cobar.

1. Councillor Quigley requested if the General Manager had received any information regarding Warren Arts Council funding. The General Manager advised he was still in the process of following this matter up.

- 2. Councillor Quigley requested how much funding had been internally restricted for the Council Chambers building improvements and if a meeting could be held. The General Manager advised there was \$350,000 in internally restricted funds and that he would arrange a meeting.
- 3. Councillor Quigley explained and reminded Councillors of the Warren Healthy Town Challenge. This Challenge currently had over 100 participants, with applications closing tomorrow and he encouraged all to participate.

- 1. Councillor McCalman AM expressed concern at the length of time it had been taking to finalise the works on the water valve pit in Oxley Park near the tennis courts.
- 2. Councillor McCalman AM advised he had received a request if the Macquarie Park sign could be moved closer to the road.
- 3. Councillor McCalman AM expressed concern on the use of the street sweeper to pick up excess aggregate off the town streets.
- 4. Councillor McCalman AM expressed concern on the use of the new mower to cut grass on the road verges and areas other than within Council's parks.

### By Councillor Taylor

1. Councillor Taylor expressed concern that people riding unregistered motorbikes at the RV parking area in Bob Christenson Reserve were annoying visitors and they were observed leaving. Councillor Taylor enquired if some type of barrier could be placed on the levee in that area.
