## Warren Shire Council to Undertake Night Road Rehabilitation Works at Warren Roundabout and Oxley Highway Rail Level Crossing

## Warren, NSW — Tuesday 17 June 2025

As part of its ongoing commitment to providing safe and reliable road infrastructure for Warren Shire residents, Warren Shire Council will begin essential night road rehabilitation works at two important locations:

- Warren Roundabout: Monday, 23 June to Wednesday, 25 June 2024
- Oxley Highway Rail Level Crossing: Saturday, 5 July to Tuesday, 8 July 2024

Work will be carried out overnight **between 6:00 pm and 5:00 am** to minimise disruption to daytime traffic and local businesses.

These projects involve asphalt rehabilitation designed to enhance road safety, improve durability and ensure a smoother driving experience for all road users.

During the works:

- Detours will be in place around the Warren Roundabout.
- At both sites, signage and traffic control will be used to manage traffic safely.

Council's Mayor, Greg Whiteley, said the night works reflect Council's continued focus on road safety and community convenience.
